



## Happy 2017!

Dear friends,

Firstly let me offer you our prayers and best wishes for 2017. May this year be one in which you go with God into whatever adventure he has in store for you and may it bring you joy and fulfilment.

A great writer on Fresh Expressions described pioneering as feeling like you're at the top of the roller-coaster and at the bottom at the same time<sup>1</sup>. There is joy, excitement, and hope as you meet people and they start to connect with your community, as you see them starting to respond to the love of Jesus and begin to be transformed by it. But at the very same time there is also strong sense of anxiety that everything is very small, very fragile, and could disappear in a puff of smoke at any moment!

When I read that in a book it resonated with me immediately. That is where we live most of the time! I actually met the author, Dave MALE, at a conference this summer and thanked him for writing it.

As followers of Jesus we have to hold two things in tension:

*Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does." (John 5 :19 NIV)*

*I can do all things through him (Christ) who strengthens me. (Philippians 4 :13 ESV)*

In the first text Jesus states his inability to achieve anything by himself except in those moments when he has aligned himself with God's will and God's power is working through him. In the second text St Paul affirms his conviction that with God's indwelling power he can face up to anything life can throw at him.

So we have this joint sense of frailty and invincibility! It is hard to hold both of those in tension, but it is our calling as followers of Jesus. Perhaps the phrase 'hopeful anxiety' best sums up how we move forward into 2017!

For us 2017 already looks like being an eventful year!

Stephen is about to begin his final year in the 3-year Pioneer Minister post; we wait to see whether this will be extended, or if God has something else for us in 2018, or maybe a combination of both – who knows!? Training and coaching pioneers is one thing that appeals.

Caleb has just begun a year-long training course at police college in France in order to move up a grade to 'Gardien de la Paix' (Police Constable).

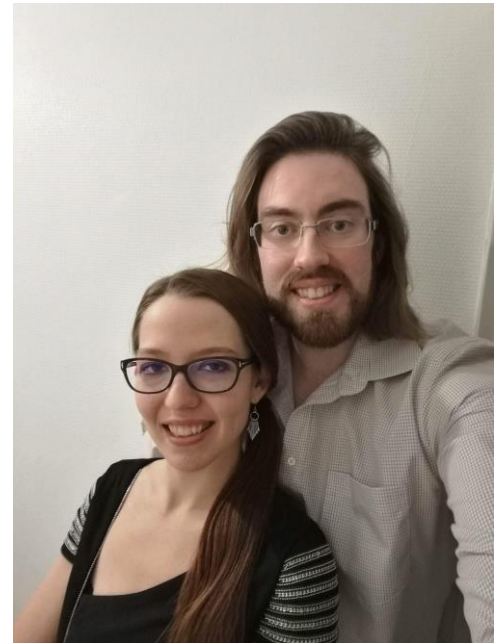
Here is a photo of him, his fiancée Carole, and Piou-Piou, the cat!
